

PRIVACY POLICY

This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, disclosure and protection of the Personal Identifiable Information (PII) we receive from its users. **By using the Site, you agree to the collection and use of this information in accordance with this policy.** If you are not of legal age to consume alcoholic beverages at the place you reside or where you are located, you should immediately leave this site, otherwise you have assumed the risk of the unauthorized use of our Site.

Information Collection And Use

While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain PII that can be used to contact or identify you. Log Data

Like many site operators, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Site. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier, which are sent to your browser from a web site, and stored on your computer's hard drive. Like many sites, we use cookies to collect information. You can, however, instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. Be aware that if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Site.

Security

The security of your PII is important to us. That is why we use security measures that comply with federal law to protect your PII from unauthorized access and use. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also restrict access to your PII to those employees that necessarily need to access it and only for business reasons, or to comply with federal and local laws, and require that any third party complies with our confidentiality and information security standards. Notwithstanding, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure, so while we strive to use commercially acceptable procedures to protect your PII, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

We do not share information with other companies for marketing purposes. We may be required by law to share some PII for the following purposes: to third parties to process or service a transaction, that you requested or authorized, to government agencies, our regulators and auditors, to third parties that assist us in marketing our products and services, to third parties that provide support for services for our products, to respond to a subpoena, court order or judicial process.
